Petitioner Sarwan Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.224 dated 15.08.2017, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana, under Sections 382 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the allegation, the present petitioner has been nominated on the disclosure statement of co-accused Ajay Pal, from whom Ford Fortuner car was recovered. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the main accused Ajay Pal has already been granted bail by the trial Court. Challan has already been presented.

The petitioner has been in custody since 06.03.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and the fact that the main accused has already been granted bail; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
