Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action to arrest respondents No.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondents No.5 to 8 were declared as a proclaimed offenders in FIR No.61 dated 27.05.2017 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S. Nagar, but till date police has not taken any action despite the fact that they are living in their houses.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has also moved a representation before respondent No.3 on 09.04.2018 and the said representation is pending consideration before him.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage as no order prejudicial to the interests of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the pleadings contained in the present petition, respondent No.3 is directed to take into consideration the pending representation moved by the petitioner on 09.04.2018 and take appropriate action in accordance with law, without being swayed away by any consideration in terms of pleadings or anything recorded in the preceding part of the order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
