This petition has been preferred by the petitioner for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of acquittal of the petitioner in a complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, though a representation has been filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2 but the same has not been taken care of till date.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, this case is disposed off by relegating the petitioner to file a formal complaint before the Incharge of concerned Police Station in respect of cognizable offence (if any). In the event of

filing such complaint, the same shall be dealt with by the officer in accordance with law. If the petitioner is still unsatisfied with the outcome, she may resort to remedy under Section 154(2) Cr.P.C. before the respondent No.2, who shall decide the representation of the petitioner in accordance with law without being influenced by any consideration or observation of the Court.
