The petitioner seeks interim bail on account of his own marriage in FIR No.222 dated 11.03.2018, registered at Police Station, Sarai Khwaja, District Faridabad, under Section 379-A IPC.

It is stated in the petition that the petitioner is getting married on 11.05.2018 and therefore, he be granted interim bail for a period of one month. The marriage functions are commencing w.e.f. 06.05.2018.

Report dated 03.05.2018, by way of affidavit of Yashpal Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sarai, District Faridabad, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. The averment regarding marriage ceremony to be held on 11.05.2018, has been verified and found to be correct.

In view of the above, the petitioner-Manish Kumar, is granted interim bail for a period of fifteen days w.e.f. 06.05.2018 on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad. He is directed to surrender before the jail authorities concerned on 21.05.2018 at 10.00 a.m.
