This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 25 dated 31.01.2018 under Sections 376, 506 IPC and Section 4 & 6 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Maloya, U.T., Chandigarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 31.01.2018 and that the trial is almost concluded.

Ms. Sunita Verma, Sr. Scientific Officer, CFSL, Chandigarh has furnished the report of DNA match in a sealed cover, which has been opened and perused. The said report has been resealed and returned with a direction that the same be placed before the trial Court, on the date so fixed by it.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view of the fact that the trial is likely to conclude early, this Court is not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.
