The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.43 dated 22.03.2018, registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, under Sections 323, 380, 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC.

As per the contents of the FIR, the petitioner and his co-accused forcibly entered into the house of one Manjot Singh and stole goods therefrom apart from causing damage to his property.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR is false. It is a counter-blast to FIR No.0030 dated 09.02.2018 (Annexure P-4) registered by the accused persons against said Manjot Singh for having murdered the brother of law of the petitioner.

At this stage, I am not in a position to say whether the FIR is a counter-blast or not. Specific allegations are there against the petitioner and in case, they are false, he will be acquitted. No case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

In view of the above, petition is dismissed.
