Learned State counsel has filed an affidavit regarding status of the pending cases against the petitioner, in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

On the basis of the affidavit, learned State counsel submits that out of total 13 cases, the petitioner has been acquitted in 7 cases and the remaining cases are still pending. Petitioner has been arrested in case FIR No.143 dated 28.09.2018 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station – Nathusari Chopta and he is in custody in District Jail, Sirsa.

This is a petition for anticipatory bail and the petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 12.05.2017. However, during the period interim protection was granted, the petitioner has committed another offence under NDPS Act. Meaning thereby, the petitioner has misused the concession of bail.

Accordingly, the present petition being devoid of any merit, is
hereby dismissed.
