The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents to get the investigation conducted in case FIR No.110 dated 04.04.2018, registered under Section 346 IPC, at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh by an officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nuh as till date the investigation has not been moved forward and neither the minor victim has been traced nor any action has been taken against the accused persons.

The status report by way of affidavit of Anil Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tauru, District Nuh has been filed. Same is taken on record.

As per the said report, the police is taking efforts to trace out the minor girl.

In view of above, the respondent(s)-State is directed to take sincere efforts to locate the minor girl Wasima and submit the status report before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nuh, within one month and

also as and when required by the Magistrate, who will monitor the proceedings in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others;** 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
