On the last date of hearing this Court while noticing that service of respondents No.4 to 6 could not be effected for want of process fee had adjourned the matter directing the petitioners to do the needful while making it clear that in case the needful is not done the petition shall be dismissed for want of prosecution.

As per office report, notices could not be issued as the process fee has not been deposited.

Learned State counsel has however submitted that pursuant to order dated 26.4.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners had been contacted and both of them have filed affidavit to the effect that they do not have any apprehension or threat to their life at the instance of their relatives.

In view of the aforesaid position wherein despite the matter having been called twice, none has put in appearance on behalf of the

petitioners and in fact, even on the last date there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners, it is apparent that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing this petition. As such, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
