Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 in respect of protection of her life and personal liberty from being invaded by respondents No.4 and 5.

Petitioner claims herself to be major and serving as Constable in Punjab Police. She has alleged overt act on behalf of her mother/respondent No.4 and his cousin brother/respondent No.5 in the context of pressurizing her to marry uneducated person, who is drug addict.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has also moved a representation before respondent No.2 on 26.03.2018 and the said representation is pending consideration before him.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let

requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage as no order prejudicial to the interests of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the pleadings contained in the present petition, respondent No.2 is directed to take into consideration the pending representation moved by the petitioner on 26.03.2018 and take appropriate action in accordance with law, without being swayed away by any consideration in terms of pleadings or anything recorded in the preceding part of the order.
