The petitioners seek directions to the respondents to conduct a fair investigation into the allegations made by them.

A perusal of the petition shows that a police party came to the house of the petitioners on 28.04.2015 at 3.30 a.m. They were in a drunken condition and started making enquiries from the petitioners. They fired gun shots at them resulting in injuries to them. They were admitted to hospital and a complaint was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, but no action was taken against the police officials. Subsequently, it transpired that FIR No.61 dated 24.04.2015, has been registered against petitioner No.1 at Police Station, Sarhali on the statement of one Satnam Singh, regarding theft of one motorcycle.

Additional affidavit dated 24.10.2017 of Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran has been filed. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioners themselves have got their statements recorded that a mob attacked the police party when it went to the house of the petitioners to arrest them. Fearing for their lives they fired in the air and couple of bullets ricocheted off the wall and hit the petitioners.

Thus, it is evident that the allegations made against the police officials are false. The petitioners themselves have accepted them to be false. Thus, nothing further requires to be done in the present petition and the same is dismissed.
