Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 29.04.2017 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with his other co-accused has forged the signatures of the complainant and has taken a loan against LIC policies which were in the name of the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact, the petitioner has joined the investigation, his custodial interrogation is not required and he has repaid the outstanding loan. He further states that the police has completed the investigation and prepared the challan.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Palwinder

Singh does not dispute the fact that challan in the case has been presented in

the Court.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances that the dispute is between husband and wife, coupled with the fact that the loan amount has been deposited by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.05.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
