Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.252 dated 29.10.2017, registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3(1) and 5(1) of the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and contested this petition.

Respondents No.2 and 3 have also appeared through their counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 admits that compromise has already been effected between the parties. The possession of property has already been taken and sale certificate has already been issued.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 27.04.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that compromise has already been effected between the parties, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 27.04.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
