DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sachin in case FIR No. 91 dated 22.9.2017 registered under Sections 148,149,323,324,307 and 34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines Jind, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is a young boy, has falsely been implicated in the case, whereas, he was not involved. Learned counsel further contends that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Deepak and Ankit have already been released on regular bail. The petitioner is in custody since 28.12.2017. Injured and complainant have already been examined and they have not supported the case of the prosecution.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not disputed the

custody period as well as recording of the statement of complainant and injured and the fact that they have not supported the case of the prosecution. Learned counsel has also not disputed the factum of release of co-accused-Deepak and Ankit on regular bail.

Heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the contents of the FIR and other documents available on the file.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 28.12.2017; co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Deepak and Ankit have already been released on regular bail and complainant and injured have already been examined and they have not supported the case of the prosecution, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sachin is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
