Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 95 dated 31.03.2018, under Sections 354, 354-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

As per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner, who is a teacher was providing coaching for *Kho Kho* players. The complainant, who had cleared her 10+2 was desirous of receiving coaching. There are specific allegations against the petitioner. Delay in lodging of the FIR or the petitioner being initially found innocent during inquiry are not relevant factors at this stage to afford anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any ground to afford the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
