Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have appeared before the Sub Registrar, Mohali and sale deed has been executed and possession of the plot in dispute has also been delivered to the complainant.

Accordingly, interim order dated 27.04.2018 passed by this Court in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

However, it is made clear that the amount of ₹ 8,50,000/-, which has been mentioned in the letter of possession would be subject to calculation. Both the parties are also directed to appear before the Investigating Officer with their respective calculation as to how much has been paid and how much remains to be paid.

In case there is any difference of the amount, parties are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
