Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.507 dated 04.12.2017, under Sections 341/395/397/379-IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the statement of complainant has been recorded by the trial Court as PW2 and he has not supported the prosecution version and he failed to identify the accused persons who were present in the Court at the time of his deposition. He further submits that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Ravi and Krishan, have already been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court noticing the above said fact that the complainant has not supported the prosecution version.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish, has filed custody certificate and as per the custody certificate, the petitioner is in custody for the last about 07 months and 25 days and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact that the complainant has not supported the prosecution version.

Without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court; complainant has not supported the prosecution version and also not identified the accused persons and also considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last about more than 07 months and is not involved in any other case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
