This is a petition under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection to life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Petitioner No.1 is earlier married with Gobind and having two children from him. She abandoned his house and started living with co-petitioner Atma Ram. She has not obtained divorce from her first husband.

It has been submitted that the divorce petition is still pending before District Judge, Hisar.

To the mind of this Court, the petitioners are not entitled to invoke the provisions of Section 482 Cr.P.C. before this Court. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to move similar petition before District Judge, Hisar.
