LISA GILL, J.

Grievance of the petitioner was that no action was taken by the police authorities despite registration of FIR No. 0373 dated 15.11.2016 under Section 376 IPC registered at Police Station City Barnala.

As per status report by way of affidavit dated 11.07.2017 of Sh. Rajesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Barnala, it is mentioned that finding no substance in the complaint made by the petitioner, a cancellation report was prepared and submitted before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, submits that cancellation report was not accepted and re-investigation was directed. After re-investigation, a cancellation report has again been submitted on 15.05.2018 and the matter is pending.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are called for in this case. Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy/remedies as may be available to her in accordance with law

including that of challenging the presentation of the cancellation report.

Present petition is disposed of.
