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**ANITA CHAUDHRY, J**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.44 dated 22.07.2017 registered at P.S. Women, Fatehabad, under Sections 376-D, 450 and 506 of IPC Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is said to have taken place on 11.07.2017 at about 1:00 p.m. and the complainant is a married woman who alleges that two persons came suddenly in the fields and finding her alone raped her. Counsel further states that the FIR had been lodged on 22.07.2017 after a delay of 11 days.

Learned State counsel submits that the medical was got done on 22.07.2017, the day the FIR was lodged. He also states that the complainant and the husband have been examined.

Considering the peculiar facts of this case and also keeping in mind the fact that the victim and her husband have been examined and the period of custody of the petitioner but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
