Petitioners-Monu and Imran have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.15 dated 27.02.2018, registered at Police Station GRP, Patiala, under Sections 399, 401 and 411 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the basis of secret information that the present petitioners and co-accused were present near piles of shacks at Rajpura

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Yard alongwith deadly weapons and were preparing to commit a dacoity in train. Thereafter, raid was conducted and the present petitioners were apprehended at the spot. One knife etc. from each petitioner has been recovered.

The petitioners have been in custody since 27.02.2018. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping them in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, nothing stated above shall constitute my opinion on merits of the case.
