Through the instant petition preferred under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought bail, in case bearing FIR No.14 dated 22.02.2018, under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar Rural.

It is the allegations in the complaint that Rajinder Kumar son of Harmesh, Nitin Kumar and the present petitioner have duped a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- from the son of the complainant on the pretext of sending him abroad. The money was transferred in the bank account of the petitioner but the said person was neither send to abroad nor his money was returned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR, therefore he is not liable for the same.

To the mind of this court, huge amount of Rs.6,00,000/- have been transferred in the bank account of the petitioner therefore, this was his liability to return the same but he failed to discharge the same.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the seriousness of the offence, the petitioner is not entitled to grant the concession of bail.

Dismissed.
