Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the petitioners' commercial vehicle having been burnt down by respondents no.4 to 7 (as alleged), no action has been taken in respect thereof, even after more than 2 weeks of the occurrence, which is stated to have taken place on the night of 2/3.1.2018, despite representations moved to various police authorities, including to the Additional Deputy Commissioner (North), Amritsar.

Photographs of a fully burnt vehicle have also been annexed with the petition.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to go into the matter and to take a decision thereon as per law, within a period of 1 month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
