Prayer made in the instant petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.187, dated 19.09.2017 i.e. (Annexure P-1) under Sections 420/494 of IPC registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.
