The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 92 dated 13.06.2013 registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, on the ground that a compromise has been effected amongst the parties. Vide order dated 30.4.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court for getting their statements recorded. Learned trial Court had been directed to submit its report as regards genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kharar has been received. It has been reported that statements of the complainants Rajender Gautam and Ravi Malhotra as well as of all the petitioners/accused have also been recorded, as per which the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any coercion and undue pressure. The trial Court has opined that the compromise is genuine and has effected voluntarily and out of free will of the parties.

In view of the aforesaid report, this Court is satisfied that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Consequently, the

FIR as well as the subsequent proceedings are quashed.
