The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.137 dated 1.9.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 120-B added later on of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

Heard.

Learned State counsel states that only an amount of ₹ 50,000/- was paid to the petitioners and that amount has been recovered from him. He further states on instructions from ASI Om Parkash that the petitioners has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 27.4.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make himself available for
interrogation by the police as and when required;

- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
