On 07.10.2014, the Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court on 04.11.2014 to get their statements recorded with reference to the compromise, which has been entered into between the parties. As per the report of the Court below, despite opportunities given, none had appeared before the trial Court to get their statements recorded. As a matter of fact, one of the accused persons is a proclaimed offender.

Even today none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Therefore, the contention of the petitioner that there is a compromise entered into between the parties, cannot be accepted.

The present petition accordingly stands dismissed.
