In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on anticipatory bail in F.I.R. No.73, dated 28.04.2016, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

2. The petitioner was already on bail earlier in the case, but could not attend the proceedings in the Ld. Trial Court on 19.04.2018, on account of illness, and to support his contention, a copy of the Medical Slip (Annexure P-2) has been annexed.

3. Admittedly, the contraband seized from the petitioner in the case was below the commercial quantity.

4. In the circumstances, the matter is disposed off with a liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a week from

today, and seek fresh bail, during which period execution of the warrant issued against him shall remain stayed. This order shall, however, automatically stand vacated after 04.05.2018.
