It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the life and liberty of the petitioners is at jeopardy at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9. It is asserted that highlighting the said aspect, petitioners have submitted a representation dated 28.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat)-respondent No. 2. She states that the petitioners will also approach the Station House Officer, Police Station Punhana, District Nuh (Mewat)-respondent No. 3 and put forth their grievance in the form of a representation, which may also be considered.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, in case the petitioners approach the Station House Officer, Police Station Punhana, District Nuh (Mewat)-respondent No. 3 by submitting a

representation, the same shall be considered and similarly, the Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat)-respondent No. 2 shall consider the representation dated 28.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if required.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
