Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5, who are father and mother of the petitioner respectively.

The present petition was filed on 26.04.2018 and thereafter, on 12.11.2018, the petitioner had submitted an affidavit to the police that she does not apprehend any threat to her life and liberty at the hands of her parents i.e. respondents No.4 and 5.

Once the petitioner has informed the police by way of affidavit, it was the duty of the petitioner to apprise this Court that she has submitted an affidavit to the police stating therein that she does not apprehend any threat to her life and liberty. But by not informing this Court, she has withheld this crucial information from the court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner who is present in Court, seeks withdrawal of present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
