This petition under Section 407 read with 482 Cr.P.C. has come about by the petitioner husband whereby he has sought transfer of application for maintenance filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. bearing MNT No.224 dated 28.02.2017 titled 'Anju Bhardwaj versus Ashwani Sharma' pending before the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rajpura. The prayer is that the same be transferred to a competent Court at Ambala.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records. The only and only ground that has been pleaded and canvassed before this Court on behalf of the petitioner is that it is extremely difficult for the petitioner to come to the Court of Rajpura as there is threat to the life of the petitioner.

To the specific query of the Court what sort of threat is being received by the petitioner or any supportive evidence to that effect, learned counsel was totally at loss of words and purely on the ground that similar matters have been transferred, certainly to the mind of this Court, is no ground to accede to the prayer of the petitioner.

The petition has been apparently moved for a motivated cause and does not satisfy the conscience of the Court as well as the settled principles for such a transfer. The petition being hopelessly without any merit stands dismissed with special costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the High Court Legal Services Committee.
