Petitioner-Harjinder Kaur has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.10 dated 06.06.2015, registered at Police Station NRI, District Amritsar, under Sections 420, 120-B, 419, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that complainant-Parminder Kaur has got registered the present FIR alleging that her brother-Harinder

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Singh sold her property by impersonating some lady. The allegation against the present petitioner is that she impersonated as Parminder Kaur at the time of execution of the sale deed.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 15.02.2018. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
