Petitioner has approached this Court, praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.123, dated 30.05.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 307, 506, 109, 120-B IPC at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar Commissionrate.

As is apparent from the record, the petitioner was granted bail by this Court vide order dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure P-2). On the very next date, which was fixed before the trial Court after he was granted bail, he has not appeared in the Court, because of which his bail bonds obviously stand forfeited. No ground for grant of anticipatory bail is, thus, made out.

The petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
