Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.114 dated 20.02.2017 under Sections 323, 325, 307, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 20.04.2017 and all the private witnesses have already been examined and only the official witnesses remains to be examined. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that two co-accused of the petitioner namely Pramod and Sohan have been granted the concession of bail vide order dated

21.07.2017 passed in CRM-M-25170-2017 and order dated 04.09.2017 passed in CRM-M-30077-2017 respectively. It is further submitted that conclusion of the trial will take long time and the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lalit Kumar, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial lockup for more than 01 year and the case is still at the stage of recording the prosecution evidence, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his personal bail in a sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
