The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.137 dated 17.7.2011 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 395, 353, 186, 224, 225, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Heard.

The petitioner was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. to face trial under Sections 307, 395, 353, 186, 224, 225, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner and he has also surrendered before the learned trial Court.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police ;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
