Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 4 in the context of evil design of the private respondents for getting the sale deed executed as well as threatening and harassing the petitioner for ulterior motives. Seeking declaration for annulling the sale deed cannot be entertained in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C, however, for protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner, respondent No.2 can be asked to look into the matter in the light of representation dated 03.04.2018 filed by the petitioner before I.G, Zone-I, Patiala which was duly marked to respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents No.1 to 3 as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on merits of the case, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove. It is made clear that this Court is not in a position to comment upon validity or otherwise of the sale deed executed by the petitioner on 09.02.2018.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
