The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.20 dated 08.06.2016, registered at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Tarn Taran (later on enhanced offence vide Rapat No.17 dated 18.10.2016, under Section 302 IPC), under Sections 307, 452, 323, 324, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to order dated 30.04.2018, the petitioners have joined investigation and have been cooperating therewith. This is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State and further submitted that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 30.04.2018, is made absolute.
