GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.16 dated 09.03.2016 under Sections 447, 506, 511, 427/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 30.04.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners namely Harmander Singh @ Mander Singh and Tarsem Kumar @ Megraj as well as of Mandeep Kumar-complainant have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant-Mandeep Kumar has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.16 dated 09.03.2016 under Sections 447, 506, 511, 427/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
