BALWINDER KUMAR AND ORS VS STATE OF PUNJAB

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Vide judgment dated 13.10.2004, the appeal filed by appellants Balwinder Kumar and others was allowed to the extent that sentence awarded to them was reduced to the period of sentence already undergone by them and fine imposed on appellant no. 1-Balwinder Kumar was increased to ₹10,000/- and of other appellants to ₹5000/-. It was also ordered that in the event of fine being not deposited by appellants, they shall undergo further sentence of six months.

A reference has been made by the Registry on the letter written by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana that appellants have not put in appearance, as such, order passed by this Court could not be implemented.

Learned State counsel submits that steps are being taken to apprehend appellants and for recovery of fine from them.

In view of submission of learned State counsel, reference made by Registry stands disposed of with direction to Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana to take further appropriate steps in the matter.
