LISA GILL, J.

The petitioners, who are the parents-in-law of the complainant, seeks quashing of FIR No.89, dated 25.04.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanwind Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing for some time seeks to withdraw this petition for quashing of FIR No.89, dated 25.04.2014, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioners to avail all remedies/remedy as may be available to them in accordance with law. It is however submitted that the petitioners are aged persons. Petitioner No.1 has been advised surgery for both the knees, therefore, personal appearance of both the petitioners before the learned trial Court be exempted.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Needless to say, in case an application for exemption from personal appearance is moved by the petitioners, the same be considered sympathetically by the learned trial Court in accordance with law.
