Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon an order of this Court, dated 21.04.2018, passed in **CRM-M-13984-2018**, by which his co-accused who is attributed a similar role, i.e. Deepak, has been admitted to bail on the ground that firstly, he had been in custody for more than 04 months, with 23 prosecution witnesses still to be examined; and moreover, the person injured in the occurrence stated to be “all right”, as per the instructions received by learned State counsel from the ASI present in Court on that date.

The petitioner also having undergone 03 months and 10 days of actual custody, as per the custody certificate filed by learned State counsel in Court today, and none of the witnesses still stated to have been examined, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
