This petition has been pending since 1997.

On 20.07.2017, on a persistent request of the petitioner, notice was issued to the Gram Panchayat where after on 23.08.2017, the Gram Panchayat was represented and was asked to furnish the correct addresses of unserved respondents no.40, 45, 51, 54, 57, 83, 108, 109, 116, 119 and 124. The petitioner had also failed to take steps to implead the legal representatives of deceased respondents no.68 and 73 and last opportunity was granted to them to do the needful while adjourning the matter to 30.11.2017. Today again learned counsel for the petitioner virtually pleads no instructions. The legal representatives of the deceased have also not been impleaded so far.

Consequently, looking on all the factors in totality, we would dismiss the petition for want of prosecution.
