1. This is an application seeking exemption from filing certificate copies of Annexure P-1 to P-4.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions.

Main Case

3. Present petition has been filed praying for protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, in view of the marriage solemnized by them against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5.
4. Notice of motion to the official respondents No.1 to 3.
5. On the asking of the Court, Mr.A.S.Dhaliwal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and three copies of the petition have been supplied to him in the Court.
6. The documents annexed by the petitioners including the Aadhar Card and Marriage Certificate show that both are major and are present in

Court also duly identified by their counsel. They apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

7. Present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to take care of life and liberty of the petitioners, as per law.

8. However, it is made clear that this order may not be construed as expression of an opinion on legality and validity of the marriage of the petitioners.

9. In case any criminal case is pending against petitioner No.2, this order shall not be any hindrance to proceed according to law.
