Prayer in this petition is for setting-aside the orders dated 16.03.2018 (Annexure P2), dated 28.03.2018 (Annexure P3) and dated 10.04.2018 (Annexure P4) in FIR No.121 of 2012 under Sections 447, 506, 109 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh, vide which the bail order of the petitioners has been cancelled and non-bailable warrants has been issued for 27.04.2018.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners subsequently appeared before the trial Court and are facing the trial.

Counsel for the State has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

Counsel for the petitioners has further argued that the FIR pertains to the year 2012 and till date, the prosecution has not completed its evidence and, in fact, no evidence has been led by the prosecution and even the statement of the complainant has not been recorded.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a

direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of 09 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
