Pursuant to the order dated 23.01.2018, learned counsel for the State has produced in Court today the report of the Chemical Examiner, stating therein that no poison was detected in the viscera that was sent for examination.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further reiterates what he had argued on 23.01.2018, that only a skeleton was recovered, the DNA of which did not match with the parents of the person alleged to be the deceased, for whose alleged murder the petitioner has been charged.

He also submits that the allegedly deceased person had a large number of cases registered against him.

Seeing the above facts and that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 2 year and 2 months as of now, with 11 prosecution witnesses still remaining to be examined, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
