Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Gurvinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation but money is still to be recovered from him, as has been alleged to have been given by the complainant.

Whether or not the money was actually given on an alleged promise of getting two persons recruited in the Punjab Police, would be a matter of evidence.

Consequently, with the co-accused of the petitioner already having been admitted to bail as recorded in the last order of this Court, the order dated 01.05.2018, admitting the petitioner to interim bail, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
