The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, “Cr.P.C.) for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.39 dated 23.3.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 427 of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) (offence under Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a compromise has already been effected. Parties have also moved CRM-M-17084-2018 for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise which is still pending.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners-Karan son of Lal Singh, Mani @ Baljinder Singh son of Manmohan Singh, Mannu @ Bhupinder

Sukhveer Singh are ordered to be released on regular bail subject to the conditions, if any, and on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
