DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Surjeet @ Surjeet Singh in case FIR No. 62 dated 7.5.2017 registered under Sections 201/204/420/465/467/468/471/379/380 IPC and 138 of Electricity Act at Police Station Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case, whereas, he was not involved. Learned counsel further contends that on the same set of allegations but in different FIR, the petitioner has been released on bail by this Court vide order dated 15.10.2018 passed in Crl. Misc. No. M-44834 of 2018. Learned counsel also contends that investigation has been completed and challan has been presented. The petitioner is in custody since 12.9.2017 and nothing is

to be recovered from him.

Learned counsel for respondent-State has not disputed the custody period and release of the petitioner in other case.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 12.9.2017; on the same set of allegations but in different FIR, the petitioner has been released on bail by this Court vide order dated 15.10.2018 passed in Crl. Misc. No. M-44834 of 2018, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Surjeet @ Surjeet Singh is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
