The petitioner-Sukhwinder Kaur, seeks issuance of direction to protect her life and liberty. According to the petitioner, she has been turned out of the matrimonial home and her daughter has been taken away to Canada by her husband against her wishes. Presently, she is residing with her parents. Yet, her in-laws keep on threatening her and she fears that physical harm may be caused to her by them. A representation dated 26.03.2018 (Annexure P1) has been filed in this regard and no action has been taken thereon till date.

Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let five copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation dated 26.03.2018 (Annexure P-1), and in case it is found that the life and liberty of the petitioner is under threat, suitable action be taken within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
