This order shall dispose of two criminal miscellaneous
petitions.

Criminal Misc. No. M-18047 of 2018 is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 11.5.2017, under Sections 399 and 402 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya and second; Criminal Misc. No. M-20189 of 2018 is for setting aside of order dated 03.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur declaring the petitioner proclaimed offender in the aforesaid FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on a single default of non-appearance of the petitioner on 01.10.2017, arrest warrants of the petitioner were issued cancelling his bail bonds and surety bonds.

With regard to Criminal Misc. No. M-18047 of 2018, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within 15 days from today and the bail application, if any, shall be decided within two days.

Qua illegality of order dated 03.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) in Criminal Misc. No. M-20189 of 2018, the petitioner is given liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial Court, which he has raised in this petition for setting aside the order dated 03.11.2017 (Annexure P-4), who after hearing and perusing the record deeply, would pass an appropriate order.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.
